World Leprosy Day 2022

Event Summary

This year, NLR Indonesia collaborates with Ministry of Health (MOH), WHO Indonesia, universities, media and the public to spread the world and national messages of being united for dignity and eliminating stigma and discrimination due to leprosy,

Joint Effort with MOH

NLR Indonesia joins the steering committee led by MOH to commemorate the WLD from its kick-off event (January 31) to its peak event on April 20. NLR Indonesia speaks at one of the webinars on health promotion on February 17.. We also facilitates two radio talkshows in partnership with KBR radio network.

Radio Talkshow

NLR Indonesia partners with KBR radio network for a one-hour talkshow on stigma and discrimination reduction (January 26). Our technical advisor, dr Astri (middle) and one person affected by leprosy (right) shared knowledge and experiences about how to deal with stigma and discrimination. The radio talkshow received positive comments from listeners and live chats in Youtube, and quoted in 9 blog and media articles.

Event Summary



Deputy Minister of Health and Mayor of Tangerang city attended the kick-off and talked and shook hands with leprosy patients at Sitanala Hospital, January 31, 2022.

Working with Universities

We collaborated with Asian Medical Students Association (AMSA) of Airlangga University to educate public about leprosy and its consequences. We held a social experiment to tens of people in a public space (14 Jan, with two PEP++ field staff), IG live (26 Jan, with Dr Udeng as speaker) and webinar on stigma reduction (30 Jan with Dr Astri as speaker). The students were enthusiastic on leprosy issues as they learned from our technical advisors.

A local leprosy organisation PerMaTa based in South Sulawesi province conducted a 2022 WLD road show to 9 districts in the province.

Supporting A Local Organisation

NLR Indonesia provided support for a local leprosy organization called PerMaTa to carry out a road show (26-31 January). In the road show to 9 districts,

50 persons affected by leprosy joined and sent the messages of stopping stigma and discrimination to the public.

They also encouraged the public to go for the government's covid-19 vaccination program.
